- The 5th biggest city of Spain
- 661.108 inhabitants (2016)





- Close to the main cities of Madrid, Barcelona, Valencia, Bilbao and to the Pyrenees.

- The most important city in the Ebro Valley.

HISTORY OF THE CITY

- Founded in 14 BC by Augustus
- Roman: **Caesaraugusta**
- Islamic: **Saraqusta** (capital of the Taifa of Zaragoza)
- Christian: **Saragossa** (capital of the Kingdom of Aragon – Crown of Aragon)
- **Zaragoza**: capital of Aragon (Spain)



WHAT TO VISIT

“The essentials”

- **EL PILAR**

The **symbol of the city**.

Built in honor of the Virgin Mary.



- **LA SEO CATHEDRAL**

Curious past: Roman temple, Visigoth church and Mosque.

Artistic styles: Romanesque, Mudéjar, Renaissance, Gothic and Baroque.

Also called Cathedral of San Salvador



- **LA ALJAFERÍA**

Fortified medieval **Islamic palace**.

The northernmost Arab palace in the world.

- **ROMAN RUINS**

Forum, River Port, Public Baths
and Caesaraugusta Theatre



- **LA LONJA**

Example of Aragonese Renaissance civil architecture



University at Magdalena Sq. (1587-1973)

The University of Zaragoza was originally a School of Arts and in 1542 the Emperor Charles V decided to turn it into a Studium Generale (General University for all the Sciences).
